Entries will be accepted between 10am and Noon at Milberger's Nursery the day of the contest. Judging will begin at 12:15pm. Winners will be announced at 1:30pm.

Entries are limited to homegrown tomatoes only.

Judging Criteria

(as suggested by our horticulture friends at Texas AgriLife Extension Services - Bexar County.)

CHERRY TOMATOES: Entries must be a group of six (6) tomatoes. In maturity, they must range from green, to blush (beginning to ripen) or red (fully ripe). All tomatoes must be uniform in every way. Skin should be firm, crack-free, and smooth. Each tomato should have the stem (calyx) left on, and the calyx should be green and fresh.

LARGE TOMATOES: Contestants must bring three (3) "marketable" tomatoes. In maturity, they must range from green, to blush (beginning to ripen) or red (fully ripe). All tomatoes must be uniform in every way. Skin should be firm, crack-free, and smooth. Each tomato should have the stem (calyx) left on, and the calyx should be green and fresh.

Your homegrown tomatoes will be judged by a panel of experts, and could win a great prize - complements of Milberger's. And every one who enters will receive a \$10.00 Milberger's Gift Certificate.

(One Gift Certificate per family, redeemable at Milbergers on the day of the contest.)



Entry forms that will be filled out on the day of the judging will ask for name of the variety of tomato. You may also bring pictures of your tomato plants during the growing season.

Decision of the judges is final. One tomato will be declared the Grand champion Tomato of the season.
